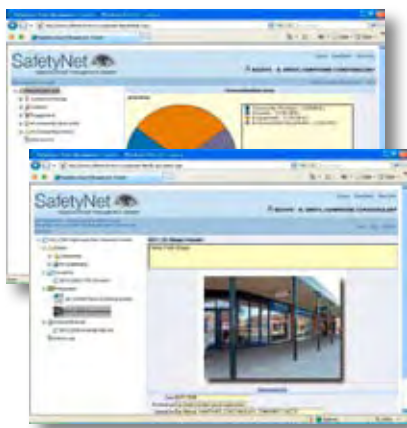

SafetyNet is a web-based software tool designed to assist Crime and Disorder Reduction Partnerships (CDRPs) and Community Safety Teams with neighbourhood management tasks.

Built originally for Hampshire Police, SafetyNet now provides a full Anti Social Behaviour case management, combined with extensive project-based problem solving and Neighbourhood Management.

For Community Safety Teams within CDRPs and the Police, SafetyNet makes project management easy and cost-effective. SafetyNet replaces unstructured and disorganised exchanges of spreadsheets and documents with simple browser-based access to relevant neighbourhood information.

User-friendly views of current projects, actions and responsibilities can be accessed by suitably authorised partners. Housing, Social Services, Fire & Rescue and other services with an interest in neighbourhood management can be granted selective access, helping to share community resources easily and quickly.



SafetyNet in action: a case study from Hampshire Police

Hampshire Police contracted for the development of the SafetyNet system, which is now implemented in Hampshire Constabulary and CDRPs across the county. Recent enhancements to the original problem-solving package, Prime, described in the 2006/07 SPI Good Practices Guide, include:

- Neighbourhood Management System
- Anti-Social Behaviour Case Management

Significant joint design work has gone into these additional products which means that new Police Forces and CDRP member organisations can benefit from the developments at beneficial pricing.
